

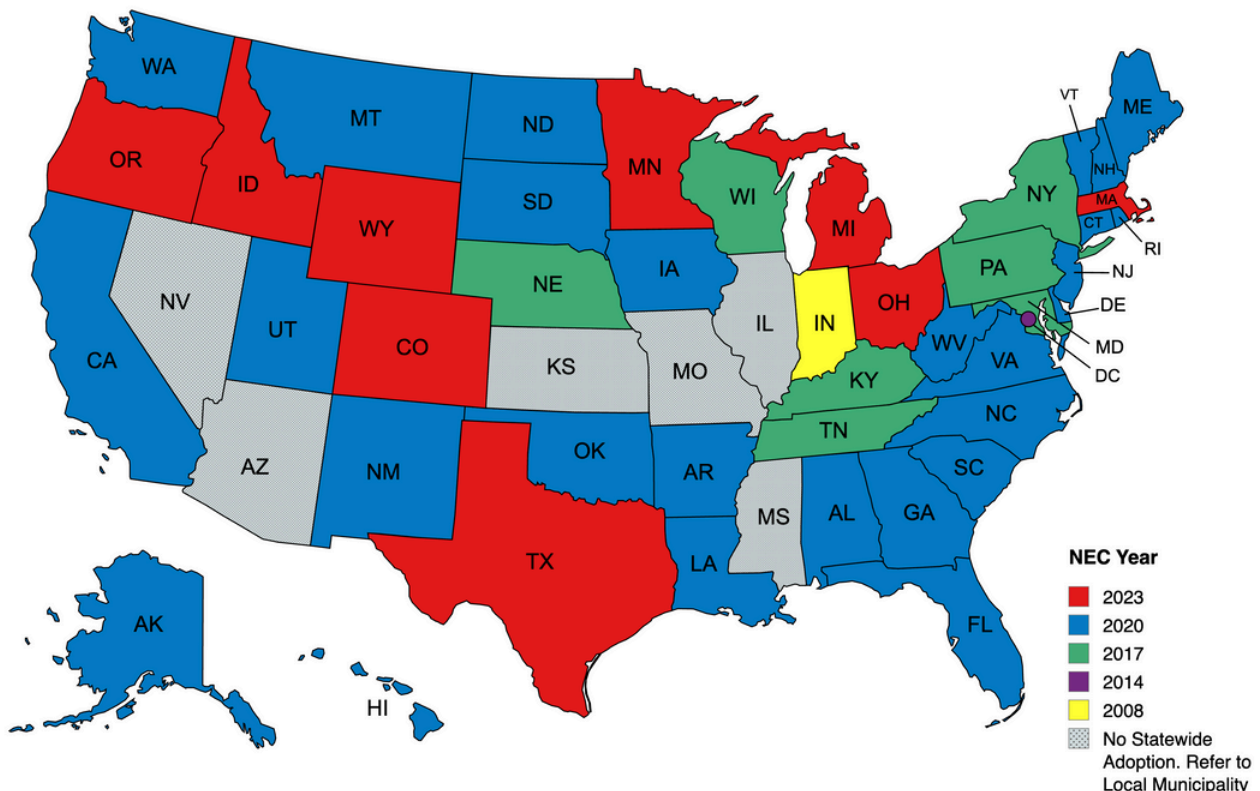

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: My state has no set adopted NEC. What should I do?

A: If there is no statewide adoption of an NEC, that generally means there is no state exam. Any exam you take would be with a specific city or organization, and they should be able to direct you to which NEC version they test on.
